

### FSSM Regulations 2018

#### 1<sup>st</sup> State to release FSSM Regulations, 2018 for all the 114 ULBs

#### Objective

An important Regulation from the FSSM Regulations 2018 for Municipalities and NACs

As per Regulation 8 (1) No vehicle shall be engaged in the collection, transportation and disposal of faecal sludge and septage, unless it is registered as a Septage Transport Vehicle (STV) with the Municipality or NAC and possess a valid inspection certificate under these Regulations, and any person found doing so in contravention of these Regulations shall be liable to penalty as specified in Schedule-II and the vehicle along with equipment may be SPIZED



### FSSM Regulations 2018

CHAPTER IV of FSSM Regulations, 2018: MANNER OF REGISTRATION OF SEPTAGE TRANSPORT VEHICLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF ITS OPERATORS

- Registration of Septage Transport Vehicle (STV) with the urban local body.
- Installation of GPS in the vehicles for tracking by the ULB.
- Emptying of Septage Transport Vehicles at Treatment Plant or designated Deep Row Entrenchment (DRE) by ULB
- In case of Accidental spillage, the vehicle operator shall be responsible to take immediate action to prevent further spillage of sludge or septage

Any STV in contravention of the above shall be fined under Schedule II "Penalties and Fines" of FSSM Regulations 2018.




# FSSM Regulations 2018 and congruence with Police Act 2003

Section 74 of The Orissa Urban Police Act, 2003 states that, "No person shall defile or cause to be defiled the water in any public well, tank, reservoir, pond, pool, aqueduct or part of a river, stream, nullah or other source or means of water supply, so as to render the same unfit for any purpose for which it is set apart by the order of the competent authority."

One cesspool vehicle indiscriminately discharging is equivalent to 5000 people defecating in the open






### Results due to current practices








Lay out and connect the hoses from the truck to the tank or pit to be emptied. If extension pipes are used then connect only through coupling





Locate septic tank and open it by removing access ports



Section 233 of OM Act, 1950 empowers all ULBs to issue notices for prohibition of desludging from cesspool vehicles to open drains/sites

Enforcement of regulations – INR 50,000 penalty for indiscriminate dumping – Additional Chief Secretary



### Deep Row Entrenchments



#### **Land Selection Criteria for Deep Row Entrenchments**

- Not flood prone or should be above recorded flood level
- Not water-logged
- Low water table
- ☐ Soil type should be porous and allow soak away
- Reasonably flat
- ☐ Sufficient buffer distance to habitable properties (200 m minimum)

- Not close upstream of water intake, well, exposed aquifer (at least 2 km), no ground water
- use for potable or contact or agriculture purposes etc downstream (of aquifer)
- Accessible by vehicles (road strength, width, bridges, headroom, slope)
- Tanker movement should not cause nuisance to neighbourhood
- Compatible to adjacent and neighbouring properties usage
- ☐ Close enough to allow logistics of sludge transportation














### Check points for ULB vehicles

- 1. Documentation of all process Signed copy of receipt from customer and FSTP operator
- 2. Scheduling of cesspool operations
- 3. Carry registration certificate with vehicle Original
- 4. Adhere to time as per client requirement
- ESCROW account is a must wherever the operation is outsourced from ULB to private agency
- 6. Money collected to be deposited to ULB within 24 hours (ULB operators)
- 7. GPS should be installed and functional in all cesspool vehicles
- 8. Penalty clause as per contract
  - 50% money to be penalized of the trip if provision of service is not given within 3 days
  - 25% of money to be penalized of a trip if accidental spillage is not cleaned within 2 days
- 9. First aid kit and fire extinguisher are kept in the vehicle before it goes to the collection site

### Responsibility of cesspool operator

- 1. The owner of the vehicle shall be responsible for safe transportation of faecal sludge and septage to the designated site notified by the ULB
- 2. The owner shall ensure that the STV shall not be used for the transportation of any other materials or liquids till the registration is in force.
- 3. Record keeping
- 4. Compliance with the PPEs and sanitary workers welfare Insurance or safety
- 5. And compliances for drivers
